and before the presentment of this indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, did then and there intentionally and knowingly murder more than one person during the same criminal transaction, to-wit: the said HENRY WATKINS SKINNER did then and there intentionally and knowingly cause the death of an individual, Twila Busby, by repeatedly striking her about the head and face with a foreign object, to-wit: a wooden club, and the said HENRY WATKINS SKINNER did then and there intentionally and knowingly cause the death of an individual, Elwin Caler, by stabbing the said Elwin Caler with a knife, and the said HENRY WATKINS SKINNER did then and there intentionally and knowingly cause the death of an individual, Randolph Busby, by stabbing him with a knife,

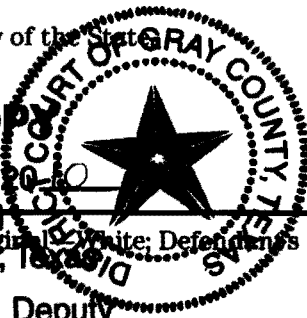
